Members need to bring their chosen book / books, pen and note paper.


Term 1

Date	Topic	Discussion
2nd February	Holiday Reading	What have you been reading during the holidays? Which book did you enjoy the most? Why?
2nd March	Choose a book about Travel and/or famous travellers?	What did you learn about the places visited or the people travelling? What did you find most interesting?
6th April	"Progress?"	Do you agree that this was progress? What were the flow on effects? How did the book make you feel?

Term 2

Date	Topic	Discussion
4th May	"My Happy Place" Choose a book that most closely matches your happy place.	Why is this your happy place? Did you enjoy the book? Why or why not?
1st June	"Schooldays" Choose a book that is involves schools or learning.	Did the book take you back to your schooldays? Was the book well written? What did you find interesting about the school?

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Term 3

Date	Topic	Discussion
3rd August	Choose a book that uses letters or diaries to help tell the story.	How effective was the use of the letters/diaries to help tell the story? Which character could you empathise with the most?
7th September	“Eureka!” Choose a book that involves some sort of discovery.	Did you enjoy the book? What was discovered? What impact has the discovery had on our lives today?

Term 4

Date	Topic	Discussion
2nd November	“Beauty is in the eye of the beholder” Choose a book about an artist or art gallery that you are interested in.	Why did you choose this book? What did you learn about the artist or gallery you chose? What did you find most interesting?
7th December	“Books That Made Us” Choose a book or books that you think helped “make” you.	Why did this book have such a big impact on your life? Would you recommend this book to others? Why or why not?
